


ST. HELEN'S: BACK TO SCHOOL BASICS

PARENTS AND STUDENTS CAN EXPECT REGULAR COMMUNICATION, IN-CLASS INSTRUCTION & SUPPORT, PROVINCIAL CURRICULUM, ASSESSMENT AT REPORT CARDS. CLASSES WILL BE DIVIDED INTO 6 COHORT GROUPS, WITH LESS THAN 60 KIDS. (LARGER CLASSES SPLIT INTO LEARNING PODS)
