

St. Helen's Restart Plan

NO ONLINE LEARNING

As directed by the Ministry of Education, CISVA schools will open in Stage 2 of the Ministry of Education's [K-12 Five-Stage Education Restart Plan](#) this September. All students will return to school on Thursday, September 10, 2020, for full-time instruction. There will be no remote learning in Stage 2. Schools will organize students in cohorts to limit contact and possible exposure, and implement newly revised [provincial health guidelines](#) to maintain a healthy and safe environment.

-Cohort 1: KA, KB

-Cohort 2: 1, 2

-Cohort 3: 3A, 3B, 4

-Cohort 4: 5A, 5B

-Cohort 5: 6A, 6B

-Cohort 6: 7A, 7B

All students will have wristbands with different colours to indicate which cohort they belong to.

Recess and Lunch:

Play areas will be divided into four zones. There will be a rotation schedule for recess and lunch outside.

There will be two teachers and two EA's outside on supervision for every break

Physical Education, Music, and Library will continue as usual- students will be going to the classrooms

An extra shield will be provided for specialists

Outdoor Education is DAY TRIPS only

Schedule for Camp:

-September 9th- grade 6 & 7 at Camp Summit

-September 10th- grade 5 at Evans Lake

-September 11th- grade 4 at Evans Lake

Please note: Mr. Perrotta will send an electronic permission slip from grades 4-7 which you must return by September 4th. Please note this year we are not taking any parents to any of the camps due to COVID 19.

School Bus:

The bus will be cleaned and disinfected according to the BCCDC's standards

A physical barrier will be used between the driver and the passengers

Students can sit 2-3 at a seat and must wear a mask

Bus will be used for the before and after school bus runs as well as a field trip

PICK UP AND DROP OFF:

- Grade 6 and 7 will use the West side of the parking lot of the Church. Parents will NOT get out of their vehicles as students will get out and go to their designated marked pylons. Staff will greet and direct students
- Grade K-5:
 - Grade K, 1, and 2 will be dropped off on Ingleton Ave
 - Grade 3, 4, and 5 will be dropped off on the West side parking lot of the Church. Parents will not get out of their vehicles.
- **If walking:** students will be dropped off my South glass doors where a health assessment will take place. The parent walks off the lot
- **If a student is late:** the parent will notify the school before arrival and call the office to report when parked or outside the school. A health assessment will be conducted to ensure safe access to the school. The student would be picked up and escorted to his or her classroom.

Environmental Measures:

- Frequently touched surfaces are cleaned 2-4 times a day
- Fixed playground equipment will be cleaned and sanitized daily
- Limit the not easily cleaned items
- Garbage and paper are recycled daily
- plexi-glass sneeze screens will be installed on all student and teacher's desk
- students are required to wear masks in all areas of the school other than the classrooms unless otherwise stated to do so
- Avoid hugs and handshakes
- Staff and students should screen themselves daily prior to leaving their homes

Staff questions to students daily:

- How are you feeling today?
- Have you had a temperature in the past 24 hours?
- Have you or anyone at home shown flu-like symptoms?
- Has anyone in your household travelled or been around anyone who has travelled in the past 14 days?
