


FSA

Hot Lunch Pilot Container Program

St. Helen's will be implementing a trial period where students will be brining containers from home for their hot lunch on Wednesday's. This will help us reduce food waste and garbage.

The 4B and 6B classes will be piloting this program starting in January 2020, with the intent to implement the Hot lunch containers school-wide, for the 2020-2021 school year.

Students will be asked to bring a container from home where they will receive their food. Any leftovers will be sent home. Since this is a trial period, if a child forgets their container we will provide them with a plate. Students from other classes are more than welcome to bring in their containers from home as well. Let's work together to reduce our carbon footprint.
