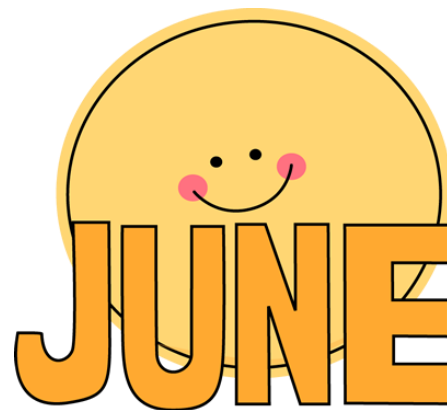
As the 2021-2022 school year draws to a close, I want to express to all of you my deepest appreciation for your support and a most earnest commendation for a job well done.

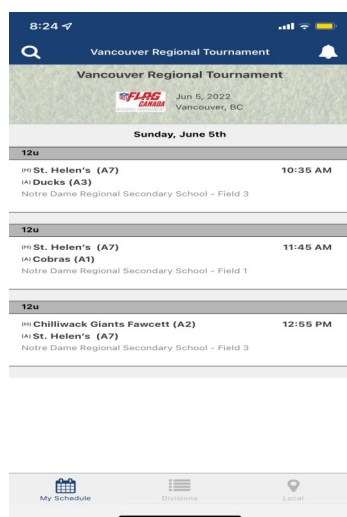

NEW UNIFORM INFORMATION

Over the past few years, uniform policy has been adapted due to Covid-19 regulations. Starting in September 2022, uniforms will return back to normal, with a few adjustments:

- Students in grades K-3 will be able to wear gym strip on days they have PE scheduled (excluding mass and special events)
